### THE CLUB

In February 1989, an advert appeared in the local papers asking if there was anyone interested in forming a local vintage/classic car club. The response was promising with two informal meetings held in the March of that year. The result then was the forming of the Wigtownshire Yesteryear Transport and Machinery Club on 03 April 1989.

From the beginning, the Club has gone from strength to strength. After a start with about six people in 1989, by present day, the Club has an active membership of just over eighty households. Various local events are visited with the old vehicles, while Galas and open days are attended and held by the Club.
